- Build a network of people who care

#### Here's the 5-step system I recommend for founders

No personal brand BS.

Just a clear path from anonymous --> trusted





### Nail your audience

Not for your product. For you.

Who should be seeing your name every week?

VCs? Founders? Heads of growth? Candidates?

Pick one and stick with it.





### Grow your network with intent

Use LinkedIn search to find high-relevance profiles

Filter by title, company size, industry, region.

These are your future hires, customers, investors. Don't let them sit cold.





### Share things worth caring about

#### A few proven formats:

- "Here's what worked for us"
- "This almost killed us"
- "Nobody talks about this, but..."
- "Why we made this unpopular decision"

This is honest signal from the trenches.



#### Engage, don't just broadcast

- Comment on relevant posts
- Follow up with people who click or reply
- DM anyone who seems curious

This is sales, not storytelling. Treat it that way.



### Automate the boring parts
