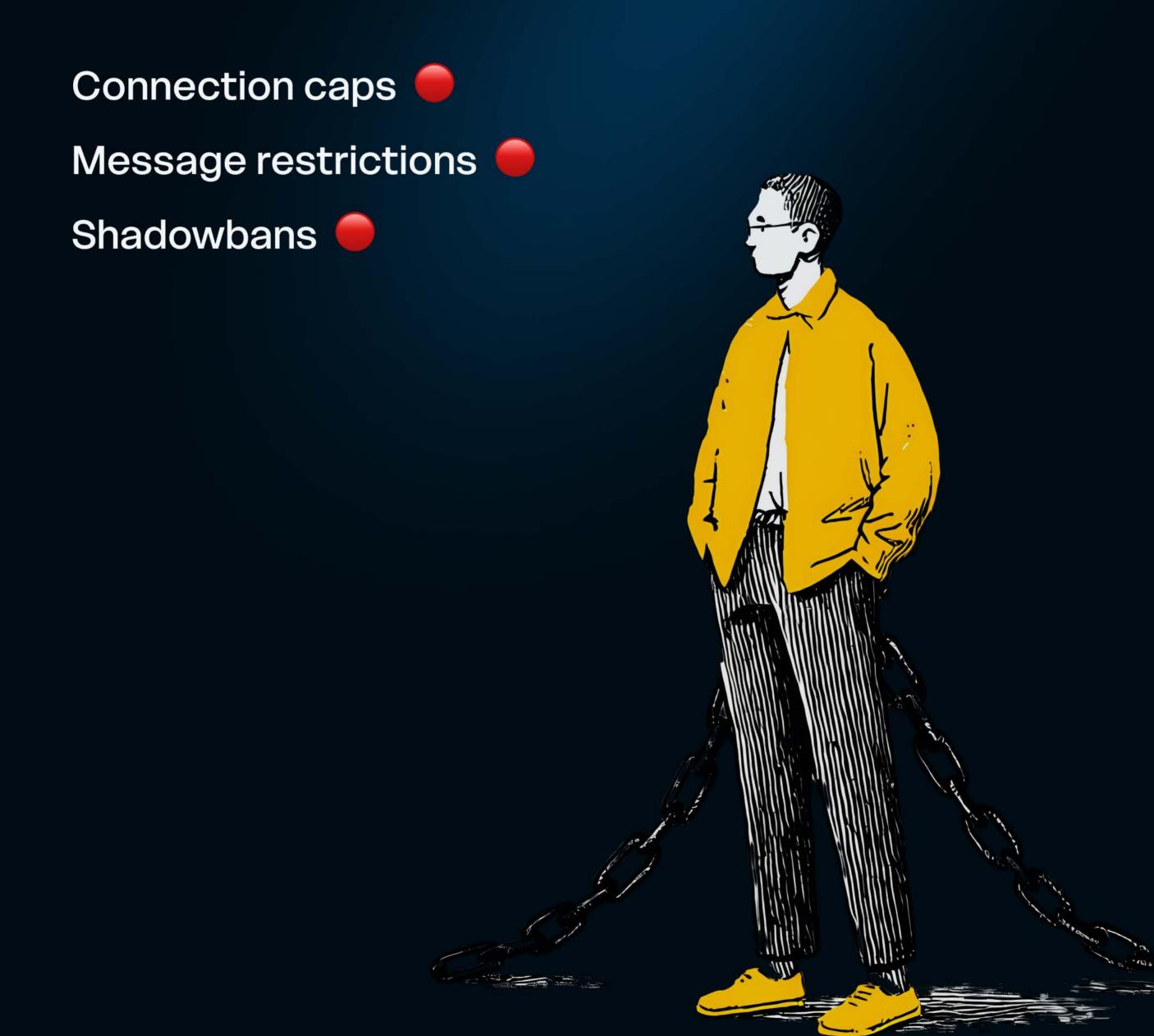
How early-stage

How early-stage founders safely message 100s of customers, hires, and investors.

Early stage founders need to move fast but LinkedIn slows you down.



This guide show how to bypass them and run 100+ high-signal convos/week safely.



To stay safe, follow these 3 hard rules

- Keep invites under 100/day
- Don't include a message with your invite
- No links, CTAs, or long walls of text in the first DM

Break these, and you'll get throttled fast.

Follow them, and LinkedIn leaves you alone.



Message people via LinkedIn Groups

Join active Groups where your ICP hangs out.

Once you're in, you can message any member, no invite needed with no limit.

Search → Join → DM

Most people still aren't using this.



Message people via LinkedIn Groups

RSVP to events your ICP is attending, or host your own.

Once they register, LinkedIn treats you like a mutual.

That means:

Message them directly. No invite needed. No limits.

It's one of the safest, least-used growth levers.

Message Open Profiles

Some people let anyone message them (these are "Open Profiles").

You can DM them directly, with no invite and no cap.

Use tools like **Evaboot** to identify them in Sales Navigator searches.

Split your outreach:

- Open Profiles = direct message
- Others = invite first

Saves 50 to 100 connection requests/week.

Want to scale past one account? Use burners safely.

Warm them up slowly over 10-14 days.

Start with <50 invites/day.

Use real photos, legit job titles, and a clean banner.
Rotate devices or IPs if needed.

When done right, burners can run quietly for months.

Avoid LinkedIn Jail

If you see a limit warning:

- Stop outreach for 3 days
- Cancel old pending invites
- Test manually before restarting automation

A **soft reset** usually works.

Ignore the warning, and you risk permanent restrictions.

Pro tip:

You can unlock more invites by raising your SSI

LinkedIn lets trusted accounts do more.

Raise your Social Selling Index by:

- Posting 1–2x/week
- Keeping a high acceptance rate
- Connecting with relevant people consistently

At >70 SSI, we've seen accounts send up to 200 invites/week.

A safe, high-output system to follow

LinkedIn lets trusted accounts do more.

Raise your Social Selling Index by:

- Send up to 75 blank invites/day to ICP leads
- Keep follow-ups light (1–2 max)
- Use Groups + Events to DM in parallel (no invite needed)
- \checkmark Only drop links after a reply or in message 2–3

This mix gives you 100+ high-signal convos/week, without tripping LinkedIn's wires.

And yes — **75/day * 5 days = 375/week**. The rest comes from replies and warm channels.

Turns out the fastest-growing teams we work with don't do this manually.

They use Tiger to automate the whole thing safely, and in the background:

- Sends blank invites + spaced follow-ups
- Pauses when someone replies
- Keeps you under the radar

Works with:

- LinkedIn search URLs
- Events
- Post likes/comments
- CSV uploads

Just a simple way to stay consistent without thinking about it.



That's the system.

Just safe, scalable outreach that works.

Use it manually. Automate it with Tiger.

Either way - this is how the top startups stay consistent, stay compliant, and book meetings at scale.
