You're doing everything "right"

- → Posting value
- Updating your profile
- Engaging daily





But leads are still random.

DMs are dry.

And every month feels like a reset.

You're not doing it wrong.
You're just missing the distribution engine.







Know What "Ready to Buy" Looks Like

Look for real buying signals on LinkedIn:

- Just changed roles
- Hiring for what you offer
- Mentioning pain points in posts
- Engaging with your competitors

Don't wait to be discovered. Find the people already leaning in.



Search Like a Founder, Not a Marketer



Use **filters** like:

- Title: "Founder", "Head of Growth", "Marketing Lead"
- Keywords: "newsletter", "ops", "ghostwriter"
- Activity: posted in the last 30 days
- Past companies your clients come from

Bonus:

People who recently viewed your profile = warm leads







Start Conversations That Don't Sell

Cold DMs shouldn't feel cold. Use simple, relevant questions like:

"Saw you're hiring for content. Are you building in-house or still figuring it out?"

or

"Noticed you're scaling your offer — how are you approaching lead gen right now?"

Short. Specific. Human.









Once someone checks your profile, it should answer 4 things fast:

- Who you help
- What you help them achieve
- Why they should trust you
- How to take the next step

No fluff. Just clarity.





Build the Anti-Cringe Follow Up System



Most deals die in silence, not rejection. Follow up like a human.

Try:

"Just bubbling this up in case it slipped through — still something you're looking at?"

Or:

"Quick ping — helped 3 others fix this last month. Want me to send over how?"

No pressure. Just context.





Test Before You Scale



Don't automate untested messages.

Do this first:

- Write 3 message variations
- Send 10 of each manually
- Track reply rate

Keep the winner, kill the rest. If it doesn't work at 10, it won't work at 100.

Build a Weekly Growth Engine

Here's the weekly rhythm that works:

- 100 targeted connections
- **←** 15−30 contextual DMs
- 5 follow-ups
- Track reply rates + results

No ads. No agency. Just systems.

When it's Time to Scale

Once you're getting consistent replies, and your profile's converting...

You shouldn't keep doing it all manually.

That's when you add leverage:

- Automate connection requests
- Send your top-performing message
- Let replies come in while you focus on client work

You're not spamming. You're scaling what already works.
